Learning Programme at Formby

Come and explore our woodlands, dunes and beach in the company of one of our Learning Guides. We offer guided walks and activities for Key Stages 1, 2 and 3 and tailored management walks for older students.

Our Programme for 2013

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| Life from a Red Squirrel's perspective (approx 1 ½ hours) | Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 | Through structured play, consider the feeding and habitat of our Red Squirrels. Older children also explore ideas around woodland competition and food chains. |
| Woodland, Life & Me (approx 1 ½ hours) | Key Stage 1 | Compare and contrast the needs of people, plants and animals in the woodland environment. |
| Strandline Investigations (approx 1 ½ hours) | Key Stage 1 | Learn about the coastline and enjoy a beach hunt along the strandline. Discuss, identify and sort your findings. Have we found anything that shouldn't be here? |
| Habitats (approx 2 hours) | Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 | Investigate four different habitats at Formby and describe how they look, sound and smell different. |
| Minibeasts (approx 1 ½ hours) | Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 | Hunt for minibeasts in two different locations. Use keys to describe and identify the creatures you find. |
| Investigating the Coastline (approx 2 hours) | Upper Key Stage 2 and Key Stage 3 | How is the eroding coastline at Formby affecting people, vegetation and the environment? |
| Conservation and Tourism Walk (1 ½ hours) | Key Stage 4 and above | Discover the challenges we face in managing such a diverse and dynamic site, with a focus on your key objectives. |



Our activities are National Curriculum linked and support Learning Outside the Classroom.
