What's on offer?

We can offer visits to Newton House that explore English, Art & Design, History and R.E. in a hand-on and investigative approach. We also offer work experience and study days for smaller groups of students for projects.

What is the cost?

We ask that the school holds an Education Group Membership. The session cost is £2 per head and £3 without a membership. For more information, check out the main learning page on the website.



What's different about Dinefwr?

We offer hands-on learning, including costume and interview work for your students to really get on the inside of how life used to be here. We also give them access to our archives for research, and to get closer to the detail of Newton House.

How many students can I bring?

Depending on the activity, we recommend a maximum of 30 students. Teachers need to ensure the appropriate adult:student ratio on the visit.
