Plant and produce sales

On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons from May till September you can buy our home-grown plants and take a bit of Gunby back home with you. Gunby produce, when available, is sold in our tea-room.

Monksthorpe Chapel

A beautiful four mile circular walk or only a few minutes by car from Gunby is Monksthorpe Chapel, also owned by National Trust. Built in 1701 and refurbished in 1840, it has a modest interior and a rare open air baptistry in its grounds. You can collect the key from our tea-room (£20 cash deposit) during normal opening times and return it before 4.30pm. The exterior of Monksthorpe Chapel and its grounds can be visited without prior arrangement and are accessible every day throughout the year. 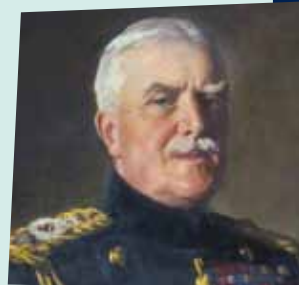
Enjoy
