# Drip Drop

## Where should we go?

*Anywhere that can drop a drip!*

## What will we need?

*A small collecting pot e.g. a thimble or water bottle lid.*

## How long will it take?

*As long as you like, or until your pot is full!*



## What do we do?

Sparkly raindrops drip and drop from all sorts of places. Take your collecting pot outside and see how many drips you can drop into your pot. You may need to look closely at leaf ends, twigs or the tips of your brolly.

Stand under a tree. Can you catch a falling drip that drops from above? Why not race another member of your group to see who can fill their pot first!

## Can we take it home?

If you've borrowed a collecting pot and card from us please return them so that others can have fun too.

## What can we do at home?

Look around your home to find different drip pots e.g. *empty tins, jam jars.*

Tap your drip pots – *do they make a sound?*

What happens when the amount of water changes? Make a drip pot orchestra and play a tune!
