Obituaries

The 3rd Lord Aberconway

Son of the donor of Bodnant Garden, he added to the property with gifts of land and the Old Mill from 1960 onwards. He was devoted to the garden and managed it on behalf of the Trust.

Lady Brunner

Widow of Sir Felix Brunner, they gave Greys Court, garden and estate to the Trust in 1968, and were generous benefactors thereafter.

Anthony Burnett-Brown

As the great nephew of the donor of Lacock Abbey, he lived at the Abbey for many years and was most generous with his time as an invaluable source of information and knowledge about Fox Talbot.

Dame Elizabeth Chesterton

Member of the Council from 1985 until 1990, nominated by the RIBA, and a member of the Architectural Panel from 1978 until 1990.

Mrs Margaret Drewe

Widow of the donor of Castle Drogo, which was given to the Trust by her late husband Anthony Drewe and his son Christopher in 1974.

Lady St Levan

Wife of the 4th Lord St Levan, whose father gave St Michael's Mount to the Trust in 1954.
