## Leeds and District Association

Leeds and District Association is independent of the National Trust and is governed by a constitution common to all the charity's centres and associations. Our affairs are run by an executive committee and an events committee. Officers and committee members are elected annually at our Annual General Meeting.

Our annual programme includes: monthly day trips to National Trust and other properties from March to October; monthly walks from April to September; monthly illustrated lectures from October to March; Autumn and New Year lunches with speakers; a Cheese and Wine Evening with holiday films; holidays and short breaks; the November Christmas Fair which is our main fund-raising event; the Christmas Coffee Morning which welcomes new members; and in March our Annual General Meeting with usually a National Trust speaker.

We meet in the Headingley area or Leeds city centre, with various coach pick-up points in North Leeds, Leeds city centre and Wakefield centre.

To join the Leeds and District Association you must first be a member of the National Trust or an affiliated organisation, or hold a current National Trust Volunteer Card. The current annual association subscription is £7 for the first member and £2 for each additional member at the same address.
