The North Hampshire Centre offers a varied programme of events and activities: illustrated afternoon and evening talks on a wide range of topics designed to appeal to all tastes; outings to National Trust properties as well as to other places of interest, often with special guided tours not available to the general public, an annual holiday, usually in the UK, with a full itinerary of visits to places of interest; a variety of social events throughout the year which present an opportunity for members to meet and to raise funds for the Trust.

Most talks and some events take place at the newly built Elizabeth Hall in Hook, but other locations are used from time to time. Full details are published in our newsletter.

Anyone wishing to join the North Hampshire Centre must be a member of the National Trust, or an affiliated organisation, or a National Trust volunteer. The annual subscription is £4 or £6 for two people living at the same address.

Members receive two newsletters a year, one in spring and one in autumn. These contain full details of our programme of events.
