

# Sculpture trail – 4 miles

## Sherborne Estate, Gloucestershire

This walk has been interconnected to make a circular walk, the most recent addition being the sculpture trail.

### Getting there:

**Road:** 3 miles east of Northleach; approach from A40 only

**Bus:** Swanbrook 53, Oxford to Gloucester, one mile walk to Lodge Park from the bus stop

**Rail:** Bus passes Gloucester station and picks up close to Oxford station

**Maps and start grid ref:** OS 163, SP158143 (parking for estate walks)

**Facilities available:** Parking, toilets (when Lodge Park open), post office in Sherborne for drinks and snacks. In Northleach, 5 miles away, there are pubs, tea-rooms and public toilets

**Terrain:** Easy walking over mainly grass paths

**Distance:** Approximately 3 miles, allow one and a half hour to complete

**Accessibility:** Easy

### Points of interest:

The paths are colour coded, take the purple route looking out for:

1. Start at the car park
2. Sherborne village and the pleasure grounds
3. Ice house
4. Ancient trees called 'veteran trees'
5. Wildlife including buzzards, foxes, hares, stoats, weasels and deer
6. Sculptures along the way

The purple route turns right and links with the blue walk to return to the car park
