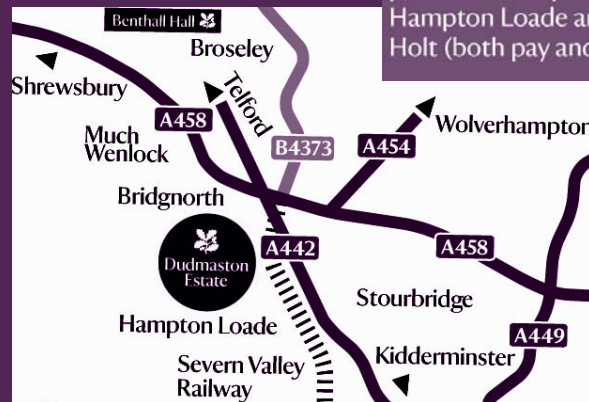
You can enjoy Dudmaston as often as you like for free - and visit hundreds more places around the country. All you need to do is join the National trust.

Foot: National Trust walks from Hampton Loade car park to the property.
Bus: Arriva Midlands 297 Bridgnorth-Kidderminster (passing close Kidderminster). **Train:** Hampton Loade (Severn Valley Railway) 1½ miles; Kidderminster 10 miles. **Road:** 4 miles south east of Bridgnorth on A442. **Parking:** free, 100 yards, in Orchard car park and parkland. Also parking at Hampton Loade and The Holt (both pay and display).

Welcome to the Dudmaston Estate



Dudmaston Hall and estate lie just south of the bustling market town of Bridgnorth in Shropshire. Dudmaston is a 17th century house set amid beautiful

rolling gardens at the centre of a 2,500 acre estate. Our cottages are scattered across this vast expanse and hidden away from the general hustle and bustle of everyday life.

Your stay can be as secluded as you like but if you want to get out and about there is plenty to do right on your doorstep.

There are walks galore across the estate; woodland trails, strolls around tree lined pools, or simply along the riverbank. The Hall and gardens, open April to September, offer a lovely day out with plenty to see and do for all tastes. The Hall, still a family home, houses an important collection of modern art, collected by the previous owner, Sir George Labouchere. The views in the garden of the Big Pool and the sculptures dotted about make it a place of discovery and contemplation. For youngsters there is an adventure playground and a whole orchard in which to let off steam.



Just up the road you will find the village of Quatt, with its Parish church and excellent local farm shop. Also the stations of the Severn Valley Railway are just a stones throw away.

The Cottages...

The cottages are ideally situated for exploring many attractions that South Shropshire has to offer, including our sister properties Benthall Hall, Wenlock Edge and Carding Mill Valley.

The famous museums of Ironbridge are only 30 minutes away and the county town of Shrewsbury a similar distance. From rolling countryside to dramatic moor land hills, South Shropshire is a place for relaxation and inspiration.

Bonemill Cottages

These are a pair of 19th century sandstone cottages sleeping 3 a piece. Standing at the heart of the Dudmaston Estate, with fine views over the surrounding countryside, both cottages are full of character and each have gardens to the front. No. 3 Bonemill also welcomes dogs who will love the walks and their own enclosed garden. With wood burners for winter evenings and peace and tranquillity outside for the long summer nights, these cottages are truly a year round place to hide away.



Sternsmill

Off the beaten track with the River Severn almost on the doorstep, Sternsmill cottage sleeps four with accommodation over 3 floors. With the old range in the lounge and the brass bed upstairs, there's a real feel of a bygone age in this cottage.

With a cave in the sandstone cliff to the rear it provides a ready made den for children, or outdoor seating, should it ever rain! Great for walking or just relaxing, your faithful canine friend can join in your holiday exploits with you at Sternsmill.



Big Mose Basecamp

This beautifully converted farmhouse is situated on the Dudmaston Estate at Mose and offers hostel style accommodation for up to twenty people.

With excellent self catering facilities for large groups, Big Mose has an enclosed courtyard and private garden with BBQ facilities plus a communal open area for additional outdoor activities. A meeting room is also available to hire on site.

The Basecamp is ideal for a variety of groups from schools, to special interest societies or even for a big family get together.

Mose Cottage



Adjacent to the Basecamp is our fabulous newly refurbished three bedroom cottage. Sleeping up to ten people in two double or twin rooms and one bunk room. It is ideal for a family break or indeed two families holidaying together.

The cottage has a stunning kitchen diner and a spacious lounge, plus a private enclosed garden for outdoor play or entertainment.

The cottage is also available to rent in conjunction with the Basecamp for those really big gatherings!
