Easy Walk 1

Marsden Moor Wildlife Wander

A Wildlife Wander is a gentle walk across part of the Marsden Moor Estate. The audio trail that accompanies this walk gives you some information about the conservation work that the National Trust is doing in this area of the estate, and also about some of the wildlife that lives here.

The map gives you a taster of what the walk is about and shows you the route, which starts from Brun Clough car park on the A62. The route is just over a mile long and the footpaths are generally good the whole way – but, as it is the moors, you may encounter some muddy patches!

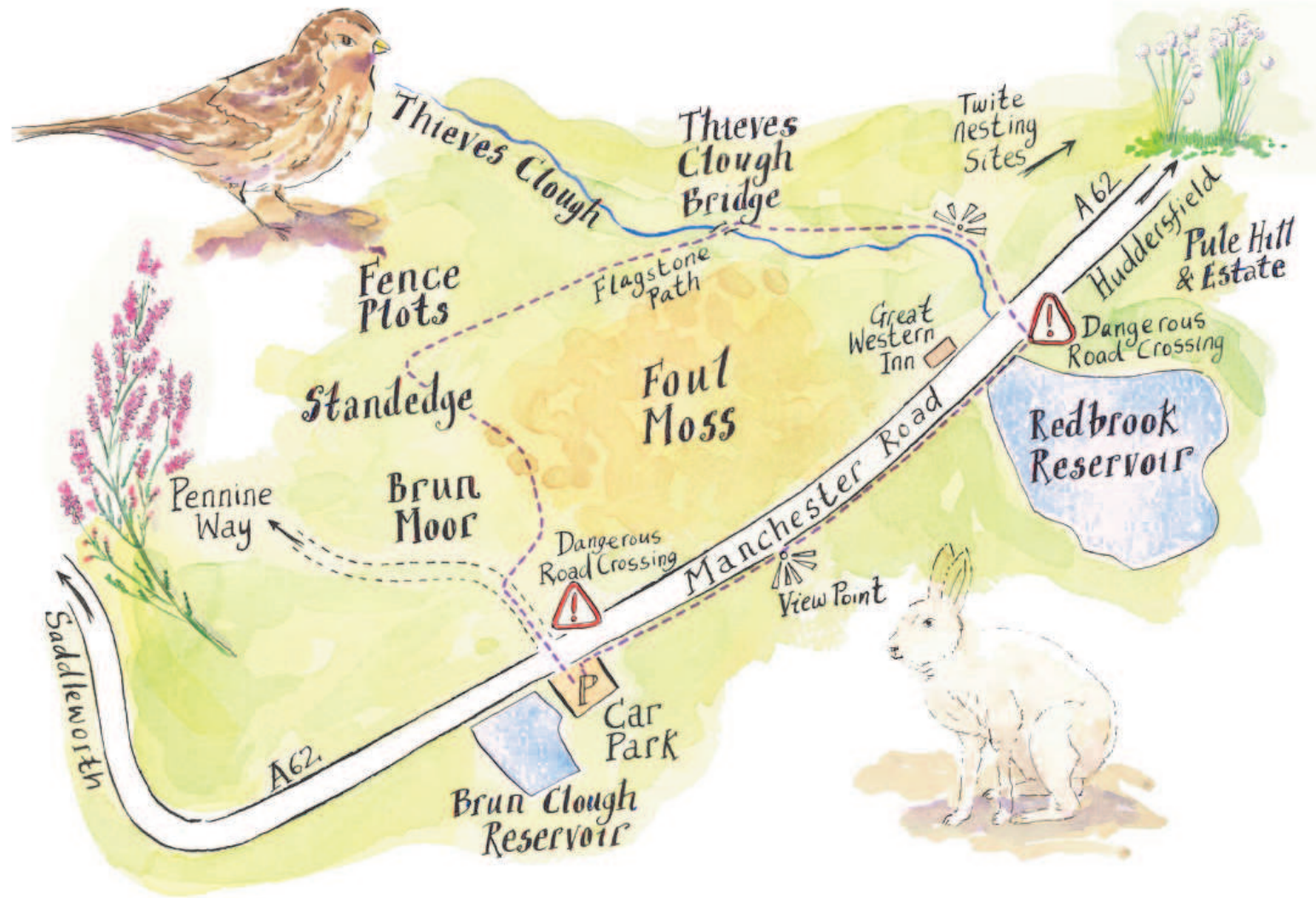




Distance: Just over 1 mile

Start at Brun Clough Car Park and go straight ahead, crossing the road, towards Brun Moor.

Terrain: generally good paths, may be muddy in places
