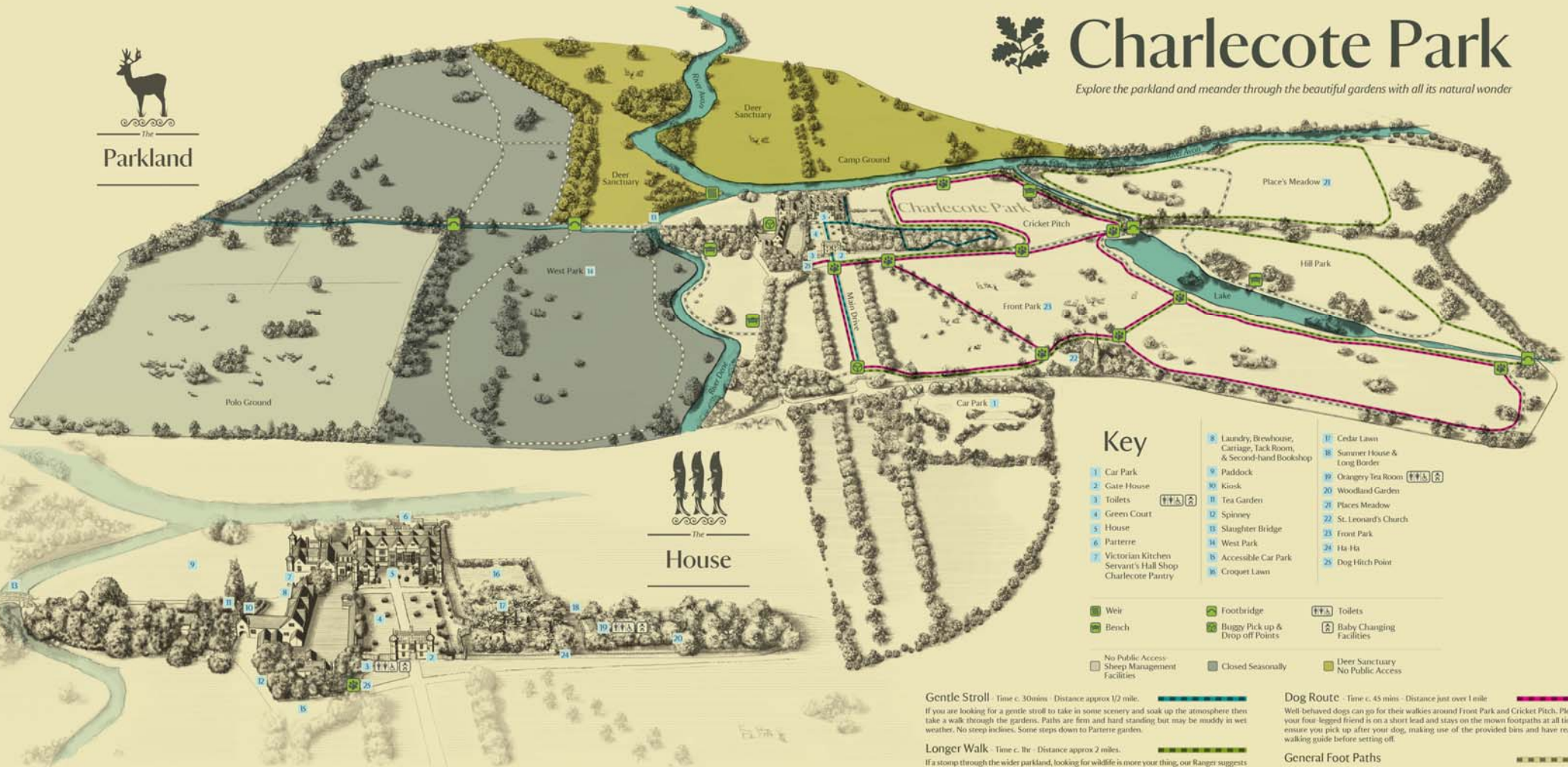




Charlecote Park

Gentle Stroll - Time c. 30mins - Distance approx 1/2 mile.
 If you are looking for a gentle stroll to take in some scenery and soak up the atmosphere then take a walk through the gardens. Paths are firm and hard standing but may be muddy in wet weather. No steep inclines. Some steps down to Parterre gardens.

Longer Walk - Time c. 1hr - Distance approx 2 miles.
 If a stomp through the wider parkland, looking for wildlife is more your thing, our Ranger suggests taking the paths around our boundary fence. Paths are grassy and uneven. May be muddy in wet weather. One steep incline in Hill Park. Sturdy footwear recommended.

Dog Route - Time c. 45 mins - Distance just over 1 mile
 Well behaved dogs can go for their walks around Front Park and Cricket Pitch. Please ensure your four-legged friend is on a short lead and stays on the mown footpaths at all times. Please ensure you pick up after your dog, making use of the provided bins and have read our dog walking guide before setting off.
