This map shows the main routes suggested for wheelchair users and children's pushchairs under good conditions.

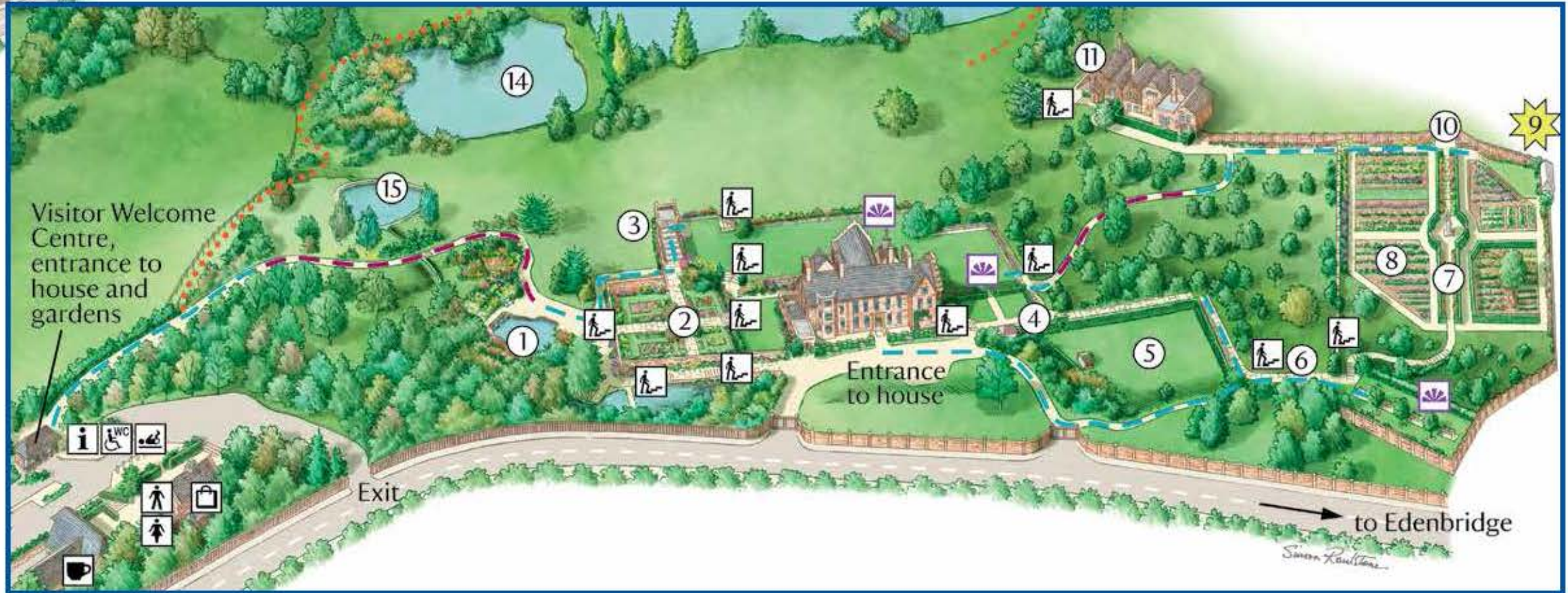
- Suggested wheelchair & pushchair route

Chartwell enjoys glorious views across the Weald but the hillside location means that the grounds are sloped in places with steps and terraces.

A team of volunteers run the mobility bus service between the Visitor Welcome Centre and the front door of the house. It is free for anyone to use and can take one wheelchair at a time.

An accessible toilet can be found adjacent to the Visitor Welcome Centre.

Wheelchairs can be borrowed from the Visitor Welcome Centre. The ground floor of the house is partially accessible to wheelchairs, and there is a virtual tour available. Unfortunately, motorised wheelchairs can't be accommodated in the house or studio.
