## Deer Park

- We have 150 fallow deer in the Park who roam freely. Remember they are wild animals so should not be approached or fed however tame they may seem.
- ☒ We ask that dogs are kept on a lead in the Park but you can let them off for a run around in the North Park.
- ☒ Please do not picnic in the Park. The spot for a picnic is in the North Park by the Log Pile or in the Gardens.
- ☒ Cycling in the Park is not permitted, unless you are under 5.
- The deer sanctuary is a deer only space and is signposted. Please do not enter this area as it is where the deer can relax away from the crowds.
- There may be areas of the Park that are closed during certain times of the year, for example during fawning season and the rut. Please ask at Visitor Reception or look out for signage.
- ⚠ There are areas of open water in the Park. Please keep children under close supervision.

••• Smooth route from Visitor Centre to House and Gardens (avoiding cobbled area).

☒ We have a volunteer operated shuttle bus between the Visitor Centre and the House and Gardens. Please ask at Visitor Reception if you would like to use this service.

☒☒ Powered mobility vehicles & wheelchairs available to loan depending on weather conditions - please ask at Visitor Reception.

☒ Induction loops in Visitor Reception, Shop, Stamford Café & Parlour.

☒ We have an accessible changing space available for our visitors in the Visitor Centre. Please ask at Visitor Reception for the key if you would like to use this facility.

☒ House is on different levels with staircases and shorter flights of steps at various points. There is a ramp to the front door of the House giving access to three rooms on the ground floor including the recreation of the First World War hospital ward. Ask in the House for a touch list of objects as you go around.
